The 2021 Season began with a sold out production of *Our Town*, re-interpreted for a modern audience by director Clayton Phillips: "I was thrilled with the outcome of this production of *Our Town*. I feel that we brought a new contemporary relevance without compromising the original script by Thornton Wilder. The original script calls for simplicity and this production was stripped of all theatrical elements until the end. This is exactly what Mr. Wilder wrote and we stayed true to that while casting a very diverse group of actors, which I believe elevated the material to "Our World."

"We were so proud of this reopening production of *Our Town*! The play holds deep resonance with The Barnstormers audience and we felt like our audiences were able to see it in an entirely new light. 

The night in early August when our beloved former board chair Margaret Cleveland died, the sky turned the most beautiful red gold over The Barnstormers Theatre upon which she had lavished so much love and care. It was as though the heavens were beaming her shining spirit right above our village,

an unforgettable night for an unforgettable woman.

Muzzy, as we all knew her, was cruelly stricken by ALS just as her cherished theater was coming back to life after the lost season of Covid blackout, a most bittersweet fulfillment of her hopes. As our board chair and then co-chair with Lou DeMaio, Muzzy had taken her uncle's creation from the sweet, old-fashioned comedies of the early 20th Century into the wilder, bawdier comedies of the 21st. She was helped also by the enthusiastic artistic stewardship of her good friend and former mentor Bob Shea, daring to launch on our small stage such popular Broadway musicals as *The Full Monty*, *Urinetown*, *Spamalot* and *The Producers*. That we are among the first of regional theaters to resume production now is thanks in large part to what Muzzy accomplished.

We will miss her wonderful laugh, her impish bright smile, her delight in any and all things theatrical and most of all her warmth and most generous heart. We can't help imagining the huge pride she would be taking in the witty and hilarious original musical fairy tale our brave young new director Joe Longthorne has launched upon the world on our very own stage this summer. She wrote her own fairy tale of a rich and enchanted life as mother, administrator, HR director, personal coach, writer, editor and fierce lover of cats, friends, family, "stories, swimming at Bearcamp, justice, chocolate chip cookies, peepers, BLTs at The Other Store, owls, giraffes, chocolate mint chip ice cream, rain, singing, theater [to repeat], poetry and all kitties."
